GO | Attractions

DeKalb County's Stone Mountain Park, which boasts one of the top 75 public golf courses in America as well as walking and biking trails, is Georgia's No. 1 attraction. Visitors can partake in other recreational activities in the area, such as hiking, biking and spa escapes. Other attractions to add to the agenda include the Fernbank Museum of Natural History and the Michael C. Carlos Museum of Emory University. DeKalb County also has exceptional shopping. Your DeKalb Farmers Market is one of the world's largest indoor markets, and visitors to the area are in proximity to five major shopping malls in the metropolitan area. DeKalb County's vibrant neighborhoods, including Candler Park and Decatur, offer pedestrian-friendly shopping districts as well as restaurants and entertainment.

GETTING AROUND | Transportation

Atlanta's DeKalb County, Georgia's third largest county, borders Downtown Atlanta and offers direct access to Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, as well as all major highways.

- Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport is just 10 miles away and the county's Peachtree DeKalb Airport (PDK) is Georgia's second largest airport.
- MARTA, Atlanta's rapid transit system, services the area, including direct access to Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.
- Major highways (I-285, I-85, I-75, I-20) offer access to hotels and attractions.
